SCHEDULE & ATTENDANCE

DO STUDENTS HAVE EARLY DISMISSAL ON WEDNESDAYS?

ACADEMICS

WHAT CURRICULUM DOES LCP USE?

LCP utilizes a rigorous, college-preparatory curriculum taught through a biblical worldview. We use Abeka for our Preschool through 1st Grade students, providing a strong foundation in early literacy, math, and biblical principles. Beginning in the upper elementary grades through high school, we primarily use BJU Press and Summit Ministries curriculum resources to deliver a challenging academic program while integrating biblical truth across all subject areas.

Our goal is to equip students to think critically, communicate effectively, and grow in their faith as they prepare for college and beyond.

DO STUDENTS TAKE STANDARDIZED ASSESSMENTS?

Yes. Students participate in MAP Growth testing to help monitor academic progress and support individualized learning.
